• Fiesta Bonita Update

Trash Pick -Up on Martin Luther King Day

The committee discussed the status of this topic. The county contract was renewed. Lora Taylor shared the committee's request but there has been no further action. Peter Simmons is willing to set up meetings with county representatives if it would help. He indicated commissioners are on a break now until the beginning of August.

Bathrooms at Soccer Field

Andres asked for the status of this. The trash issue was also brought up. Is it possible for Parks Department to share plans for upkeep and maintenance with committee, to determine if the Outreach council liaison needs to get involved?

YMCA

Angel Cerritos spoke about summer camp being in session. He also mentioned the YMCA is offering free swim lessons to children, ages 1-12. The program is called "License to Swim" and the goal is to reduce drowning deaths in local communities. Funding was provided by local residents and 80-90 students have taken advantage of the program so far. Although there is currently a waiting list, there are opportunities for sign-up in some of the upcoming sessions.

Back to School Drive

Tony asked that Michael provide the date for the next meeting so committee can get it on their calendars.

Future Award Recognition

Tony Lee remarked that the Award Recognition from last month went well, and the committee got to learn more about the community Continuing Education Program. The criterion for potential candidates is they are an unsung hero or people in the community that are doing amazing things, uplifting others. The committee discussed whether Teri Lamaine from the Bonita Springs Assistance Office had been presented a certificate in the past.
